What can this program assist with? We assist with anything related to the college access process. This includes Application Assistance; Essay Revision; Standardized Testing Resources; Scholarship Guides and Advice; Questions, Confusions and Clarifications.

Can you tell my student what courses they should take? We are not licensed professional school counselors, and can not make specific recommendations of what classes they should pick. We can discuss GPA calculations, difficulty weighting and how that effects college admissions, but not make recommendations of exact courses or schedules.

For Senior students who already applied to their choice of colleges, what else can you help with aside from Financial Aid? Honors college applications, enrollment paperwork, housing applications and more. The process does not end with an acceptance letter!

Do you work with students applying for schools overseas? We are happy to meet with you and your students regardless of their destination, but we are not specialized in higher education outside of the US.
