AFFORDABLE COST

The cost of an au pair averages just \$1,571 per month no matter how many children you have. Also, program fees can be eligible for reimbursement by a Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account (DCFSA).



HELP WITH HOUSEHOLD CHORES

Au pairs can assist with household chores related to the children including meal prep, laundry and room clean-up.



FLEXIBILITY

Au pairs can work up to 45 hours/week, including early mornings, evenings and weekends.



CULTURAL AND EDUCATIONAL ENRICHMENT

Au pairs share their culture and language and engage your children in educational activities you design together.
