



JHU Tuition Grant for Dependents

Quick Tip Sheet

Two Years

Minimum full-time service requirement for employee to qualify.

Full-Time Studies

Enrollment requirement of at least 24 degree-required credits per academic year. Disability exceptions are reviewed by JHU OIE.

26 Years Old

Qualifying dependents can receive the benefit through the end of the calendar year they turn 26.

Four Years

Maximum duration of the benefit for one dependent to receive an undergraduate degree.

50% of Tuition

Maximum annual award for 2025-2026 academic school year, up to \$33,335.

30 Days

Employee must apply in EdAssist every term, within 30 days following the term start date.

Covered Fees

Mandatory fees for all students regardless of degree program are covered; special fees, e.g. books, room & board, course-related fees, and equipment are not.

Accredited & Degree-Granting

Community colleges & four-year universities qualify; trade and vo-tech schools do not.
